Cost Breakdown of Civil Service Pay Adjustment 2001

The proposed civil service pay adjustment (i.e. an upward adjustment of 4.99% for the directorate and the upper band and an upward adjustment of 2.38% for the middle and lower pay bands), if approved, will take effect on 1 April 2001. The cost of the proposal in terms of salary and allowances (including the pay adjustment for staff in subvented organizations) is estimated to be \$3,975 million. A breakdown is set out below -
