Positioning SWD for Greater Challenge: Government Social Work Officers Association's Stance

Thank you for your letter dated 24.5.2001 and request for written submission on our view towards Social Welfare Department's re-structuring. The Government Social Work Officers Association is a staff union representing the social work officer grade in Social Welfare Department. Upon consultation of our members, the following is our stance on the proposed restructuring of Social Welfare Department.

The Association agrees and supports the proposed re-organization of structure to address new demands arising from changing welfare needs of the community. We agree that the present three-tier structure i.e. Headquarters, Region and District, which has been established for over two decades, should be reviewed. The present organization structure should be streamlined so as to increase the Department's responsiveness to meet community needs, to enhance efficiency and productivity and to meet new challenges in the planning and coordination of welfare services.

The Association is ready to work closely with the Management regarding the details of the implementation of the new structure and expects Management to respect the views from staff side in the proposed restructuring. In this regard, the Association has already initiated discussions with Management and has fruitful sharing in particular the pace of re-organization
