Dangerous Dogs (Identification of Fighting Dogs and Known Dangerous Dogs) Notice (Made under sections 8 and 13 of the Dangerous Dogs

Regulation (Cap. 167 sub. leg.))

1. Commencement

This Notice shall come into operation on 27 June 2001.

2. Collar for fighting dogs and known dangerous dogs

The keeper of a fighting dog or a known dangerous dog shall ensure that the dog is identified at all times by wearing a collar which conforms to the specifications specified in the Schedule.

Specifications of Collar for Fighting Dog

The collar must be at least 1.5 cm wide marked on its obverse side with a bright yellow background and at least 4 red diagonal stripes. The stripes must be at least 1.5 cm apart and each of them must be at least 1.5 cm wide.
