Thank you for your letter of 16 July 2002 inviting our comments on the Copyright (Amendment) Bill 2001.

The Federation fully supports the Bill to liberalise parallel importation of computer software under the Copyright Ordinance. We believe the existing 18-month ban on parallel imports is detrimental to genuine market competition and free trade. It has also created an environment for local dealers to control prices.
