COPYRIGHT (AMENDMENT) BILL 2001

Thank you for your letter dated 16 July 2002 inviting our Association to comment on the captioned subject.

Our Association supports in principal the proposal in the bill to remove the civil and criminal liabilities related to parallel importation of and subsequent dealings in computer software under the Copyright Ordinance (Cap. 528). This will encourage more competition and breakdown any trade barriers and therefore premium pricing that might have existed would equal out. The benefit is probably greater for small local businesses. We support the bill as it enhances free trade and therefore drives I.T. companies to think more internationally.
