State Government Leaders' Salary Reduction Act 2002 (Illinois, USA)

- 1. The State Government Leaders' Salary Reduction Act of Illinois (Appendix) provides for a one-time, temporary salary reduction equal to 5 working-days' salary for each of the following persons who are "in leadership positions":-
 - (i) Governor;
 - (ii) Lieutenant Governor;
 - (iii) Attorney General;
 - (iv) Secretary of State;
 - (v) Comptroller;
 - (vi) Treasurer;
 - (vii) Each member of the Generally Assembly; and
 - (viii) Head of each executive branch and legislative branch State agency.
- 2. The Act also provides that the salary reduction shall not adversely impact these persons' pension, insurance or other employee benefits.
