#### I. Meeting with the Administration

(LC Paper Nos. CB(2)1430/02-03(01) and (02))

The Bills Committee deliberated (Index of proceedings at Annex).

- 2. The Bills Committee requested the Secretary for Home Affairs to give an undertaking, in his speech during the resumption of Second Reading debate on the Bill, that the Administration would expeditiously develop a computer software for calculation of interest on maintenance arrears for use by all parties concerned. This would save the Family Court Registry a lot of time in assisting unrepresented litigants to work out the interest involved. It would also facilitate lawyers to work out the same for their clients. Moreover, the use of a common computer software to calculate the interest involved by all parties concerned would prevent any arguments on the amount of interest involved.
- 3. The Clerk would prepare a list of follow-up actions before the next meeting.

#### II. Date of next meeting

- 4. As the latest Committee Stage amendments (CSAs) proposed by the Administration might be revised upon receipt of comments from the Hong Kong Bar Association, members agreed to hold an additional meeting on 21 March 2003 at 8:30 am to consider the proposed CSAs and complete clause-by-clause examination of the Bill.
