- 2. The Bills Committee deliberated (Index of proceedings attached at the **Annex**).
- 3. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to provide a written response to the submission from the Law Society of Hong Kong dated 16 January 2002, and to the following issues/questions raised by members at the meeting -
 - (a) To consider whether the Bill had any real deterrent effect on discouraging deferred maintenance payments and whether it was worthwhile for the maintenance payees to apply for interest in legal proceedings instituted to recover maintenance arrears;
 - (b) The number of matrimonial cases handled by the Legal Aid Department (LAD) in the past two years, including a breakdown of the number of cases which sought and did not seek maintenance payment, the average amount of monthly maintenance payment awarded to the legal aid applicants and the reasons why some legal aid applicants did not seek maintenance payment from their ex-spouses; and
 - (c) The average time taken by the Social Welfare Department (SWD) to give out emergency assistance fund to maintenance payees upon the latter's applications.

III. Dates of next meetings

- 4. <u>Members</u> agreed that the next two meetings be held on the following dates -
 - (a) 18 September 2002 at 10:45 am to meet deputations; and
 - (b) 2 October 2002 at 10:45 am to continue discussion on the Bill.

5. It was agreed that the Hong Kong Bar Association and the Law Society of Hong Kong should be invited to the meeting on 18 September 2002. The clerk would circulate a list of other groups/organisations to be invited for members' comments. The Administration would also invite representatives of LAD and SWD to attend to facilitate discussion.
