Members' Motions

<u>Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General</u> Clauses Ordinance

Hon Margaret NG moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that in relation to the Attachment of Income Order (Amendment) Rules 2001, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 260 of 2001 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 12 December 2001, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 16 January 2002.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Urban renewal projects

Hon James TO moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council strongly urges the authorities to honour and fulfil their pledges on urban renewal given to the Legislative Council and the residents; and to expeditiously announce the urban renewal projects.

While Hon James TO was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 4:47 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, took the chair.

Question on Hon James TO's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Hon Frederick FUNG would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Frederick FUNG moved the following amendment to Hon James TO's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "authorities to honour and fulfil their" after "That this Council strongly urges the" and substitute with "Government to impel the Urban Renewal Authority to adopt the Government's".

Question on Hon Frederick FUNG's amendment to Hon James TO's motion proposed.

14 Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon James TO spoke on the amendment.

At 6:30 pm, while Hon James TO was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

The Secretary for Planning and Lands spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon Frederick FUNG's amendment to Hon James TO's motion put.

Hon Frederick FUNG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 22 were present, seven were in favour of the amendment and 15 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 27 were present, 15 were in favour of the amendment and 11 against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon James TO replied.

Question on Hon James TO's motion put and agreed to.

The Convention on the Rights of the Child

Hon Cyd HO moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to expeditiously harmonize legislation and policies with the Convention on the Rights of the Child so as to discharge the international obligations of Hong Kong as a territory to which the Convention applies.

Question on the motion proposed.

18 Members and the Secretary for Home Affairs spoke on the motion.

Hon Cyd HO replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.
