Proposed resolution under the Dutiable Commodities Ordinance

The Secretary for the Treasury moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that Schedule 1 to the Dutiable Commodities Ordinance be amended in paragraph 1A of Part III -

- in subparagraph (a), by repealing "2002" and substituting
 "2003";
- (b) in subparagraph (b), by repealing "2002" and substituting "2003".

Question on the motion proposed.

Two Members spoke on the motion.

The Secretary for the Treasury replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

Members' Motions

<u>Proposed resolutions under the Interpretation and General</u> Clauses Ordinance

Hon LAW Chi-kwong moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that the Drug Dependent Persons Treatment and Rehabilitation Centres (Licensing) Ordinance (10 of 2001) (Commencement) Notice 2002, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 20 of 2002 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 6 February 2002 is amended by repealing "1 April" and substituting "1 October".

Question on the motion proposed.

Hon Cyd HO spoke on the motion as Chairman of the Subcommittee on Drug Dependent Persons Treatment and Rehabilitation Centres (Licensing) Ordinance (10 of 2001) (Commencement) Notice 2002, and then in her personal capacity.

Six other Members and the Secretary for Security spoke on the motion.

Hon LAW Chi-kwong replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon LAW Chi-kwong claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 23 were present, four were in favour of the motion, 18 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 24 were present, 12 were in favour of the motion and 11 against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

The President suspended the meeting at 10:37 pm.

The second Chief Executive election

Hon Emily LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council considers that the method for the selection of the second Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region is undemocratic, depriving the general public of the right to participate in the election process, and urges the authorities to expeditiously start its consultation work on political reform.

Question on Hon Emily LAU's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon Frederick FUNG would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Frederick FUNG moved the following amendment to Hon Emily LAU's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "its consultation work on" after "and urges the authorities to expeditiously start" and substitute with "the procedure for"; and to add ", so as to allow the public to elect the Chief Executive by universal suffrage as early as possible" after "political reform".

Question on Hon Frederick FUNG's amendment to Hon Emily LAU's motion proposed.

15 Members and Hon David CHU spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Hon David CHU was speaking, the President left the chair at 11:22 am temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, took the chair.

Another five Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon Emily LAU spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Constitutional Affairs spoke on the motion and the amendment.

At 12:00 pm, while the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Question on Hon Frederick FUNG's amendment to Hon Emily LAU's motion put.

Hon Frederick FUNG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, five were in favour of the amendment and 20 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 23 were present, 12 were in favour of the amendment and 10 against it. (Voting record in Appendix IV.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Emily LAU replied.

Question on Hon Emily LAU's motion put.

Hon Emily LAU claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, five were in favour of the motion and 20 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 23 were present, 13 were in favour of the motion and nine against it. (Voting record in Appendix V.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Improving administrative procedures to enhance efficiency

Hon CHAN Kwok-keung moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to improve its administrative procedures, set up a "committee on reviewing administrative procedures", strengthen communication among bureaux and departments, and amend the relevant codes or regulations in the light of the experience in other countries, thereby enhancing efficiency and improving services for the greater convenience of the public.

Question on Hon CHAN Kwok-keung's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon Howard YOUNG would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Howard YOUNG moved the following amendment to Hon CHAN Kwok-keung's motion and addressed the Council:

PUBLIC FINANCE ORDINANCE

RESOLUTION

(Under section 7(1) of the Public Finance Ordinance (Cap. 2))

RESOLVED that -

- 1. Authority is hereby given for a sum not exceeding \$76,256,151,000 to be charged on the general revenue in advance of an Appropriation Ordinance for expenditure on the services of the Government in respect of the financial year commencing on 1 April 2002.
- 2. Subject to this Resolution, the sum so charged may be expended against the heads of expenditure, and expenditure for each such head shall be arranged in accordance with the subheads, shown in the draft Estimates of Expenditure 2002-03 laid before the Legislative Council on 6 March 2002 or, where such estimates are changed under the provisions of the Public Finance Ordinance (Cap. 2) as applied by section 7(2) of that Ordinance, in accordance with such estimates as so changed.
- 3. Expenditure in respect of any head shall not exceed the aggregate of the amounts specified in respect of each subhead in that head, by reference to percentages, in section 4(a) and (b).
- 4. Expenditure in respect of each subhead in a head shall not exceed -
 - (a) in the case of a Recurrent Account subhead, an amount equivalent to -

- (i) except where the subhead is listed in the Schedule hereto,20% of the provision shown in respect of it in the draftEstimates;
- (ii) where the subhead is listed in the Schedule hereto, that percentage of the provision shown in respect of it in the draft Estimates which is specified in relation to that subhead in the Schedule; and
- (b) in the case of a Capital Account subhead, an amount equivalent to 100% of the provision shown in respect of it in the draft Estimates.
