Location

- 4. The CYD at the junction of Chai Wan Road and Wan Tsui Road, is located in a prominent corner location in the centre of Chai Wan and is connected by a footbridge to the Chai Wan MTR station. It is surrounded by commercial and residential developments. The Chai Wan Park and the Chai Wan Indoor Games Hall are within 15 to 20 minutes' walking distance from the site while the Lei Yue Mun Holiday Village is also in the vicinity. Given its proximity to the MTR station, nearby commercial and residential developments and sports and recreational facilities, the site is suitable for the development of a centre for youth development.
- 5. The continuing expansion of the railway network in Hong Kong will further enhance the accessibility of the site. Upon completion of the CYD by end 2005, the West Rail, the Ma On Shan to Tai Wai Rail Link and the

MTR Tseung Kwan O Extension would have commenced operation. Young people from various districts, including those in eastern and western New Territories as well as eastern Kowloon, would be able to visit the CYD conveniently.
