Visit to Canada and the United States

Purpose

This paper informs the House Committee of the composition of the Legislative Council delegation to visit Canada and the United States.

Background

2. At the meeting held on 9 November 2001, the House Committee endorsed the recommendation of the Parliamentary Liaison Subcommittee that a visit to Canada (Toronto and Ottawa) and the United States (Washington DC) should be held from 16 to 24 February 2002. The House Committee also agreed that the selection of Members to form the delegation would be in accordance with the method set out in LC Paper No. CB(3) 339/00-01 agreed on 19 January 2001, i.e. Members are divided into six defined groups and each group of Members will nominate the Member(s) to occupy the allocated place(s) in accordance with its own method.
