### I Consideration of draft subsidiary legislation

LC Paper No. CB(1) 2518/01-02(01) -- Securities and Futures (Stock Market Listing) Rules

LC Paper No. CB(1) 2518/01-02(01) -- Securities and Futures (Transfer of Functions - Stock Exchange Company) Order

LC Paper No. CB(1) 2518/01-02(02) -- Securities and Futures Ordinance (Amendment of Schedule 8) Order 2002

Members agreed that the Subcommittee would scrutinize the English version of the draft subsidiary legislation. The Legal Service Division (LSD) was requested to examine the Chinese version and follow up with the Law Draftsman on drafting and other technical matters. In the event that there were unresolved issues, LSD would raise them at meetings.

2. The Subcommittee deliberated (Index of proceedings attached at the **Annex**).

#### Admin 3. The Administration undertook to take follow-up actions as follows:

- (a) to provide the new Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Securities and Futures Commission (SFC) and the Stock Exchange of Hong Kong which spelled out the administrative arrangements between the two bodies for implementing the Rules for reference of the Subcommittee as soon as it was ready;
- (b) it was suggested that sufficient time should be allowed for the market to study the new MOU before the commencement of the Rules;
- (c) SFC would enhance consultation and communication with market players in order to understand and address their concerns in the light of implementing the Rules; and
- (d) to conduct review and formulate long term measures regarding functions and responsibilities for approving listing applications in the light of the recommendations on listing matters put forward in the Report of the Panel of Inquiry on the Penny Stocks Incident.

- 4. <u>Members</u> noted the SFC's proposal to continue the current exemption granted in respect of mutual fund corporations authorized by it, from compliance with sections 38(1), 38(3), 342(1) and 342(3) of the Companies Ordinance, and the requirements under the Third Schedule to the Ordinance through the captioned Notice. The Notice was a subsidiary legislation under the Companies Ordinance and subject to negative vetting of the Legislative Council.
