Subcommittee to Study the Proposed Accountability System for Principal Officials and Related Issues

Resolution Under Section 54A of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1)

Transfer of Statutory Functions from Secretary for Housing to Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands

Introduction

This paper sets out the transfer of statutory functions currently exercisable by the Secretary for Housing to the Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands with effect from 1 July 2002.

Background

2. In the light of the discussions at this Subcommittee and views expressed by members of the public, the Administration has decided to adjust the portfolios of the policy bureaux. The draft Resolution which was issued to Legislative Council on 17 April 2002 therefore needs to be revised. This paper seeks to explain the provisions of the revised Resolution in respect of the transfer of statutory functions from the Secretary for Housing to the Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands.

The Resolution

3. The introduction of the accountability system will be accompanied by the reorganization of a number of policy bureaux. As a result, the Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands will be responsible for matters relating to housing, planning and lands. The relevant statutory functions currently vested in the Secretary for Housing and the Secretary for Planning and Lands will be transferred to the Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands.

- 4. Paragraph 12(a) of the revised Resolution provides that statutory functions currently exercisable by the Secretary for Housing by virtue of the ordinances specified in column 2 of Schedule 12 to the Resolution be transferred to the Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands. To give full effect to the Resolution, incidental, consequential and supplemental amendments, as appropriate, are introduced. Such amendments are provided for in paragraph 12(b) and Schedule 12 of the revised Resolution. Most of the amendments are to replace references to "Secretary for Housing" in the relevant ordinances with references to "Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands". Paragraph 12 and Schedule 12 of the revised Resolution are attached at Annexes A and B respectively.
- 5. The opportunity is also taken to improve the definition clauses of one of the relevant ordinances. In the Estate Agents Ordinance, the definition of "Secretary" is only provided for in the English text. A corresponding definition would be added to the Chinese text.
- 6. A summary of the major statutory functions of the Secretary for Housing under existing legislation and the textual amendments to the relevant ordinances is attached as Annex C.

Advice Sought

7. Members are invited to consider paragraph 12 and Schedule 12 of the revised Resolution.
