Resolution Under Section 54A of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1)

Transfer of Statutory Functions from Secretary for Commerce and Industry to Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology

Introduction

This paper sets out the transfer of statutory functions currently exercisable by the Secretary for Commerce and Industry to the Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology with effect from 1 July 2002.

Background

2. In the light of the discussions at this Subcommittee and views expressed by members of the public, the Administration has decided to adjust the portfolios of the policy bureaux. The draft Resolution which was issued to Legislative Council on 17 April 2002 therefore needs to be revised. This paper seeks to explain the provisions of the revised Resolution in respect of the transfer of statutory functions from the Secretary for Commerce and Industry to Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology.

The Resolution

3. The introduction of the accountability system will be accompanied by the reorganization of a number of policy bureaux. As a result, the Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology will be responsible for matters relating to commerce, industry, information technology and broadcasting. The relevant statutory functions currently

vested in the Secretary for Commerce and Industry and the Secretary for Information Technology and Broadcasting will be transferred to the Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology.

- 4. Paragraph 1(a) of the revised Resolution provides that statutory functions currently exercisable by the Secretary for Commerce and Industry by virtue of the ordinances specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to the Resolution be transferred to the Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology. To give full effect to the Resolution, incidental, consequential and supplemental amendments, as appropriate, are introduced. Such amendments are provided for in paragraph 1(b) and Schedule 1 of the revised Resolution. Most of the amendments are to replace references to "Secretary for Commerce and Industry" in the relevant ordinances with references to "Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology". Paragraph 1 and Schedule 1 of the revised Resolution are attached at Annexes A and B respectively.
- 5. A summary of the major statutory functions of the Secretary for Commerce and Industry under existing legislation and the textual amendments to the relevant ordinances are attached as Annex C.

6. Members are invited to consider paragraph 1 and Schedule 1 of the revised Resolution.
