I. Election of Chairman

Mr Fred LI was elected Chairman of the Subcommittee.

II. Meeting with the Administration

- 2. The Subcommittee deliberated (Index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).
- 3. The Subcommittee took a vote on Mr Tommy CHEUNG's proposal that the Administration should be requested to withdraw or repeal the three Regulations. Five members excluding the Chairman were present during the voting. Ms Cyd HO, Mr WONG Yung-kan, Mr Albert CHAN and Dr LO Wing-lok voted against the proposal; Mr Tommy CHEUNG voted in favour of the proposal. The Subcommittee decided not to pursue Mr Tommy CHEUNG's proposal and continued examination of the three Regulations.
- 4. The Subcommittee requested the Administration to provide further information on the following -
 - (a) How to ensure that the legislative proposal would not have the effect of "killing" the live quail trade; and
 - (b) The considerations for granting a licence for quail farmer/wholesaler/retailer after the coming into effect of the proposed Regulations.
- 5. The Subcommittee agreed to invite representatives of quail farmers/wholesalers/retailers and the catering industry to present their views on the Regulations at the next meeting. To allow time for detailed scrutiny of the

Regulations, the Subcommittee also agreed that the Chairman should move a motion to extend the scrutiny period of the three proposed Regulations to the Council meeting on 5 December 2001.

- 6. The Subcommittee agreed to hold the next meeting on 13 November 2001 at 8:30 am.
- 7. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 10:40 am.
