2. The Administration's written response to the views expressed by members and the deputations at the meeting on 4 March 2002 was tabled at the meeting. Two submissions from the Christian Zheng Sheng Association Ltd and the SER Foundation for Humanitarian Aid were also tabled.

(*Post-meeting note*: Four more submissions from the following centres were circulated to members after the meeting -

- (a) The Society for the Aid and Rehabilitation of Drug Abusers;
- (b) Wu Oi Christian Centre;
- (c) Glorious Praise Fellowship H.K. Ltd (further submission); and
- (d) Operation Dawn.)

### Members' views

- 3. Mr James TO was of the view that the commencement of the Drug Dependent Persons Treatment and Rehabilitation Centres (Licensing) Ordinance (the Ordinance) should be deferred until there was a clearer picture regarding the zoning issues. He indicated that he would move a motion to repeal the Drug Dependent Persons Treatment and Rehabilitation Centres (Licensing) Ordinance (10 of 2001) (Commencement) Notice 2002 (the Commencement Notice).
- 4. <u>Dr LO Wing-lok</u> was opposed to deferment of the commencement date when only a small number of centres might need to apply for rezoning and the Government had pledged to provide all necessary assistance.
- 5. <u>The Chairman</u> urged the Administration to provide the following reassurances to centre operators to address their main concerns -
  - (a) there would be no immediate closure of centres unless in very exceptional circumstances such as heavy rainfall causing danger of landslide;
  - (b) centres which had to be relocated would be allowed to continue operation at their existing premises until the new premises were ready; and
  - (c) communication with centre operators would be further enhanced to foster mutual trust.

### The Administration's stance

6. The Administration pointed out that delaying the commencement of the Ordinance by several months would not help change the requirements these centres would need to comply with. With the assistance the Administration was rendering to centres and the further measures to improve co-ordination in implementing the licensing

scheme, the Administration held the view that the licensing scheme should commence on 1 April 2002 as planned and agreed by all the parties concerned, including the affected centres.

7. The Administration undertook to consider the Chairman's suggestion to invite interested centre operators to join the inter-departmental working group which it had agreed to establish. The Administration also undertook to provide a revised version of its written response incorporating further information on issues of concern raised at the meeting.

# Extension of scrutiny period and report to the House Committee

- 8. The Subcommittee noted that a motion to extend the scrutiny period of the Commencement Notice to 13 March 2002 would be moved by the Chairman of the House Committee at the Council meeting on 6 March 2002 and that a report on the deliberations of the Subcommittee would be made to the House Committee on 8 March 2002.
- 9. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 10:25 am.
