## LegCo Members' meeting with Kowloon City District Council Members on 14 March 2002

## <u>Issues raised by members of Kowloon City District Council (KCDC) at the meeting</u>

- (a) KCDC members had expressed grave concerns about the problems arising from the poor conditions of the eight "Wan" streets in Hung Hom.
- (b) Some LegCo Members attending the meeting considered that urban redevelopment appeared to be the best alternative for resolving the problems arising from poor management of private streets. They hoped that these private streets in Hung Hom would be included in the 225 projects to be undertaken by the Urban Renewal Authority (URA). KCDC members were of the view that URA should speed up its progress of work for the benefits of the community as a whole.
- (c) The issue relating to the management of private streets was referred to the LegCo Panel on Home Affairs for follow-up action. A letter was sent to the Director of Home Affairs seeking her confirmation as to whether the Administration would resume a private street if all owners have given their consent.
