## L.N. 6 of 2002

Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Cap. 549)

(Commencement) Notice 2002

Under section 1(2) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, I appoint 1 March 2002 as the day on which---

- (a) sections 108(1), (2), (3)(b), (4) and (5)(b), 151, 164(a)(i) and (ii) and (b) and 168(b);
- (b) section 164(a)(iii) (but only to the extent that new section 28(3)(h) of the Medical Registration Ordinance (Cap. 161) relates to a Chinese medicine practitioner registered or listed under the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Cap. 549));
- (c) section 165 (but only to the extent that new section 31 of the Medical Registration Ordinance (Cap. 161) relates to any Chinese medicine practitioner registered or listed under the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Cap. 549));
- (d) section 168(a) (but only to the extent that new section 5(1)(d) of the Undesirable Medical Advertisements Ordinance (Cap. 231) relates to Chinese medicine practitioners registered or listed under the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Cap. 549));
- (e) section 170(a) (but only to the extent that new paragraph (f) of the definition of "clinic" in section 2 of the Medical Clinics Ordinance (Cap. 343) relates to a Chinese medicine practitioner registered or listed under the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Cap. 549)); and
- (f) section 170(b) (in respect of new paragraph (c) of the definition of "medical treatment" in section 2 of the Medical Clinics Ordinance (Cap. 343), and new paragraph (d) of that definition but only to the extent it relates to a Chinese medicine practitioner registered or listed under the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Cap. 549)), of the Ordinance shall come into operation.
