Statutes of the Chinese University of Hong Kong (Amendment) Statutes 2002 (Made by the Council of The Chinese University of Hong Kong under section 13 of The Chinese University of Hong Kong Ordinance (Cap. 1109) with the approval of the Chancellor)

## 1. Interpretation

Statute 1 of the Statutes of The Chinese University of Hong Kong in Schedule 1 to The Chinese University of Hong Kong Ordinance (Cap. 1109) is amended by adding---""unit" (單位) means an institution established or formed by the Council under section 12 of the Ordinance.".

2. The Senate

Statute 14 is amended in paragraph 4 by adding---

- "(ja) to assign teachers---
  - (i) to Faculties, Departments and Schools of Studies; and
  - (ii) to units, if the Senate thinks it fit in relation to such units;".
- 3. The Faculties and the Graduate School

Statute 15 is amended in paragraph 2---

- (a) by repealing "shall be" where it first appears;
- (b) by repealing "and".
- 4. The Departments

Statute 17 is amended in paragraph 3 by repealing subparagraph (2) and substituting---

- "(2) A teacher, who contributes substantially to the teaching of students pursuing courses of study within the purview of a Department but who is not assigned to that Department, becomes a member of the Board of that Department on being nominated by that Board and approved by the Senate.".
- 5. Appointment of Academic and Senior

Statute 20 is amended---

- (a) in paragraph 2(e)---
  - (i) by adding "or head of the unit" after "Department";
  - (ii) by adding "or head" before "shall";
- (b) in paragraph 3(e), by adding "or head of the unit" after "Department";
- (c) in paragraph 4(e), by adding "or head of the unit" after "Department". Made this 15th day of January 2002.

The current provisions under the Statutes of The Chinese University of Hong Kong ("the Statutes") in Schedule 1 to The Chinese University of Hong Kong Ordinance (Cap. 1109) provide that teachers have to be assigned to Faculties of the University. These amendments to the Statutes provide for greater flexibility in the assignment of teachers and allow the Senate to assign teachers to Faculties, Departments, Schools of Studies and units of the University.
