## L. N. 69 of 2002

Rehabilitation Centres (Appointment) Order (Made under section 3 of the Rehabilitation Centres Ordinance (Cap. 567))

1. Commencement

This Order shall come into operation on 11 July 2002.

- 2. Appointment of rehabilitation centres
- (1) Each place or building specified in Schedule 1 is appointed to be a rehabilitation centre for the purpose of being a place of confinement in which a young offender may be detained in custody under section 3(a) of the Ordinance.
- (2) Each place or building specified in Schedule 2 is appointed to be a rehabilitation centre for the purpose of being an institution in which a young offender may be required to reside after studying, working or engaging in other approved activities under section 3(b) of the Ordinance.

- 2. Chi Lan Rehabilitation Centre (parts of the buildings situated at 303 Chi Ma Wan Road, Lantau Island that are until 10 July 2002 known as Dormitory 4 and Block 10 of Chi Ma Wan Drug Addiction Treatment Centre)
