"Artemether; its salts

Etanercept

Lumefantrine; its salts

Moxonidine; its salts

Rilmenidine; its salts

Ziprasidone; its salts

Zoledronic acid; its salts".

Substances required by regulation 9 to be sold by retail only upon a prescription given by a registered medical practitioner, registered dentist or registered veterinary surgeon

The Third Schedule is amended in part A by adding -

"Artemether; its salts

Etanercept

Lumefantrine; its salts

Moxonidine; its salts

Rilmenidine; its salts

Ziprasidone; its salts

Zoledronic acid; its salts".
