- 2. Please provide a sample of the certificate of good title for the Bills Committee's reference.
- 3. On the proposals about equities and unregistered interests set out in paragraph 26(b) of the paper on "The Conversion Mechanism" (LC Paper No. CB(1)1464/02-03(04)) -
  - (a) please elaborate on the proposals and demonstrate how cases of different scenarios would be handled under the proposals, including the case of WONG Chim-ying v. CHENG Kam-wing; and
  - (b) please advise on the impact of the proposals on existing common law practice.
