Follow-up actions to be taken by the Administration

2. The Administration was requested:

Section 8B of the Buildings Ordinance (BO)

(a) to provide information on the range of the length of time and the average time taken by disciplinary boards to complete disciplinary proceedings in respect of registered contractors over the past three years. A member was concerned that if disciplinary proceedings took unduly lengthy time to complete, the contractor concerned could retain his name in the relevant register for as long as three years (subsection (12));

Section 24 of BO

(b) to advise when an order issued under section 24(2) or (2A) will be registered with the Land Registry (subsection (2C)) and confirm whether there would be a lapse between the issue of an order and its appearance in the records of the Land Registry;

Proposed section 24C of BO

(c) to consider the viability of providing a performance pledge on the time required by the Building Authority to lodge in the Land Registry an appropriate instrument of satisfaction against a notice for demolition or alteration of building or building works (subsection (6));

Proposed section 29A of BO

- (d) to advise on the drafting criteria for adopting the phrase "to the satisfaction of the Building Authority (BA)" or "in the opinion of BA" in the Bill; and
- (e) to explain the difference between subsections (1) and (4).
