2. The Bills Committee deliberated (Index of proceedings attached at **Appendix**).

3. <u>Members</u> requested the Administration to take follow-up actions in relation to LC Paper CB(1)1553/03-04(02) as below:

Clause 5, section 2B

- (a) to consider expressly providing in the Bill that businesses relating to statutory procedures could not be transacted by circulation of papers;
- (b) to undertake at the Second Reading Debate on the Bill that only procedural and administrative matters would be transacted by circulation of papers;
- (c) to clarify whether circulation of papers included e-mail;

Clauses 13, 16 and 18, sections 12A, 16 and 17

- (d) to request District Offices and other relevant bodies to conduct periodic check after the posting of a notice by Town Planning Board (TPB) in relation to planning applications and amendment of plans to ensure as far as possible the notice was kept posted during the three-week publication period;
- (e) to undertake at the Second Reading Debate on the Bill that the Administration would conduct periodic check to ensure as far as possible the notice was kept posted;
- (f) to consider devising at the Stage Two Amendment a mechanism to enable TPB to withdraw its decision where material information provided by applicants or commenters was found to be false;

- (g) to consider proposing Committee Stage Amendment (CSA) to the effect that copies of planning applications would be made available to any persons on payment of a prescribed fee; and
- (h) to make available information relating to appeal in respect of planning applications for public inspection and copy on payment of a prescribed fee. Members suggested that this arrangement should be expressly provided in law or put into place by administrative means.

4. At members' request, the Administration undertook to provide the Chinese version of the draft CSAs to Clauses 1 to 12 of the Bill as soon as possible after the meeting.
