3. <u>Members</u> requested the Administration to take the following actions:

#### Clause 8

Section 6H

(a) to review whether the English and Chinese versions of subsection (8) were consistent;

Section 6J

(b) to consider whether it was appropriate to specify under subsection (2) that the draft plan with amendments should be made available for public inspection for not less than 14 days before the Chief Executive in Council (CE in C) made a decision in respect of the draft plan. Members had different views on the issue;

#### Clause 9

Section 7

- (c) to introduce a Committee Stage amendment to subsection (2) to achieve the effect that the Town Planning Board (TPB) should advertise amendments to a draft plan once a week in two local Chinese newspapers and one local English newspaper;
- (d) to note that members had different views on whether TPB should have an independent secretariat;

#### Clause 10

#### Section 8

(e) to provide a paper to explain how the CE in C would consider a draft plan. The paper should include information on whether the CE in C was divided into small groups to consider different subjects and statistics on the time taken by the CE in C in making a decision on a draft plan; and

#### Clause 12

#### Section 12

(f) to review the merits of proposed new subsection (1A). Some members expressed concern that the present drafting would enable the Chief Executive to delegate the power to refer any approved plan to TPB for replacement or amendment to public officers. Given that such power was substantial, the authority for referral of plan should rest with the CE in C.
