Bills Committee for Town Planning (Amendment) Bill 2003

Follow-up Actions Arising from Meetings on 29 April, 31 May, 10 and 15 June 2004

Purpose

At the Bills Committee meetings on 29 April, 31 May, 10 and 15 June 2004, Members requested the Administration to :

- (a) provide information on the members appointed to the Town Planning Board (TPB), including their background, years of service in TPB and the number of advisory or statutory boards of which they are members;
- (b) explain the procedures in determining the issue of notice concerning discontinuance of unauthorized development (UD) under s.23(1) of the existing Town Planning Ordinance (TPO);
- (c) confirm the types of information that will be shown on the aerial photographs of land; and
- (d) explain the relationship between the TPO and land held by military organizations and consulates.

This paper provides the requested information.

Information on TPB Members

2. Information on background of TPB Members, their years of service in TPB and the number of advisory or statutory boards of which they are members is at **Annex**.

The Procedures in Issuing Notice under s.23(1)

3. In general, when the Planning Authority considers that there is an unauthorized development under the TPO, prior warnings (either verbal or written) will be given to the concerned parties of the unauthorized development before taking statutory actions. After collection of sufficient evidence to proceed with statutory actions, all the relevant facts and materials of the case will be submitted to the District Enforcement Conference¹ (DEC) for consideration. The DEC then decides on and monitors the progress of all the statutory actions under the TPO (including issue of notices under s.23(1), (2), (3) and (4A) and institution of prosecution actions under s.20(7), s.21(1) and s.23(6)). Endorsement of the DEC is required for all the above-mentioned statutory enforcement and prosecution actions under the TPO. For statutory actions of sensitive and complicated cases, the endorsement of the Director of Planning is required.

Information Shown on Aerial Photographs of Land

- 4. The following information is shown on an aerial photograph of land issued by the Survey and Mapping Office of the Lands Department :
 - (a) the image of the land concerned;
 - (b) the name of the district covered by the image in (a) above;
 - (c) the date and time of taking the aerial photograph;
 - (d) the height at which the aerial photograph was taken;
 - (e) the serial number of the aerial photograph (which corresponds to the flight path); and

¹ The District Enforcement Conference (DEC) is chaired by the Assistant Director of Planning / New Territories. Members of the DEC comprise the Chief Town Planner and Senior Town Planners of the Central Enforcement and Prosecution Section (which is responsible for the enforcement and prosecution in development permission areas).

(f) the issuing authority, i.e. the Survey and Mapping Office.

Land held by Military Organizations and Consulates

- 5. Land held by military organizations in the urban areas has long been covered by statutory plans and thus is subject to the TPO. These sites are mainly specified as military use on the relevant outline zoning plans. Military sites in the rural New Territories are, however, not covered by statutory plans. Since the primary objective of extending planning control to the rural New Territories in 1991 was to empower the Planning Authority to take enforcement action against the incompatible open storage and port back-up uses in these areas, it is not intended to subject areas (such as military sites) which are not susceptible to incompatible uses to statutory control. If a military site is to be released for other uses upon agreement of the Garrison, the Administration will then incorporate the released site into the statutory plan.
- 6. Land or premises used as consulates is/are subject to planning control. It is the practice to zone free-standing buildings occupied by consulates as "Government, Institution or Community" use. For consulates that are located within office buildings, the concerned sites are mostly zoned as "Commercial" use.
