Action

I. Clause-by-clause examination of the Bill

[LC Paper Nos. CB(3)16/02-03, CB(2)115/02-03(02), CB(2)553/02-03(01), CB(2)679/02-03(01), CB(2)811/02-03(01) and CB(2)813/02-03(01)]

The Committee deliberated the Administration's response to issues raised by members during the clause-by-clause examination of the Bill at the last meeting on 30 December 2002 [LC Paper No. CB(2)811/02-03(01)] and completed the clause-by-clause examination of the Bill (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

- 2. <u>Members</u> noted the 2nd draft of the Committee Stage amendments (CSAs) to be proposed by the Administration as at 3 January 2003 [LC Paper No. CB(2)813/02-03(01)]. <u>The Administration</u> had agreed to reduce the number of electors required for lodging an election petition by amending clause 40 of the Bill.
- 3. <u>Members</u> also noted that the Administration had undertaken to examine, in the review of rural elections to be conducted after the 2003 VR elections, the issue of extending the period proceeding the end of the current term of office of the Village Representative (VR) concerned for which no village by-election to fill a

vacancy would need to be held. <u>Members</u> agreed that the Chairman would include the Administration's undertaking and request the Administration to review similar requirement for the Legislative and District Council by-elections in his speech to be made during the resumption of Second Reading debate on the Bill. <u>Members</u> also requested that the Administration should re-consider in the future review whether clause 10(2) as presently worded and similar provisions in the Legislative Council Ordinance and District Councils Ordinance had adequately reflected the policy intention of requiring the receipt of the original of the signed notice of resignation.

II. Any other business

CSAs to be moved by individual members

4. <u>Mr Albert CHAN</u> advised the Bills Committee that he would move CSAs to amend clause 6(4) in respect of the functions of an Indigenous Inhabitant Representative, and delete clauses 15(4)(b) and 22(1)(b) in respect of the residency-in-village requirement for an elector and a candidate for a Resident Representative election. <u>Mr Andrew CHENG</u> said that since Hon Albert CHAN would move CSAs to delete clauses 15(4)(b) and 22(1)(b) from the Bill, he would not move any amendment.

<u>Legislative timetable</u>

- 5. <u>Members</u> agreed that that the Bills Committee would make a report to the House Committee on 24 January 2003 recommending that the Second Reading debate of the Bill be resumed at the Council Meeting on 12 February 2003. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded the meeting that the deadlines for giving notice of resumption of Second Reading debate and CSAs were 24 and 30 January 2003 respectively.
- 6. <u>Dr TANG Siu-tong</u> said that he was opposed to the Bill and requested that his view be recorded.
- 7. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 12:25 pm.
