#### I. Confirmation of minutes

### II. Outstanding issues arising from previous meetings

[LC Paper Nos. CB(2)329/02-03(01), CB(2)468/02-03(01) and CB(2)540/02-03(01)]

- 2. The Committee deliberated the Administration's responses to the concerns and issues raised by members at the meetings on 22 October, 16 November and 22 November 2002 respectively (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).
- Adm 3. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to provide a written response to the following issues –

### Electoral arrangements for representatives of fishing population

- (a) whether fishermen and boat dwellers in fishermen's villages which did not have boundaries could participate in Village Representative (VR) elections;
- (b) whether the representatives of fishermen and boat dwellers could continue to serve as members of Rural Committees (RCs); and

## Disqualification from holding VR office or being nominated as a candidate or elected as a VR

(c) whether a member of the people's congress or people's consultative body in Macau Special Administrative Region would be eligible to run for and hold a VR office under clauses 9(f) and 23(h) of the Bill.

4. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to consider the following comments and suggestions from members –

#### Subsidies for village offices and RCs

(a) reviewing the amount of subsidies granted to village offices and RCs as VR elections would be put under statutory control;

#### Eligibility of civil servants to run for and hold VR offices

(b) amending clauses 9(1) and 23(1) of the Bill to the effect that civil servants would be allowed to run for and hold offices of VRs; and

## Residency requirements on voters and candidates for Resident Representative elections

- (c) amending the Bill to the effect that a person who had close affiliations with and a residence in an Existing Village should be allowed to choose to use his residence in the Village as his principal residential address for the purpose of voter registration for the Village.
- 5. <u>Mr Albert CHAN</u> said that he would move Committee Stage amendments to the Bill if the Administration refused to accept members' suggestions in respect of paragraph 4(b) and (c) above.

### III. Any other business

- 6. <u>Members</u> agreed that the next meeting of the Bills Committee would be held on Friday, 20 December 2002 at 8:30 am to start clause-by-clause examination of the Bill, and to study the draft Committee Stage amendments proposed by the Administration.
