#### I. Confirmation of minutes

[LC Paper Nos. CB(2)690/02-03 and CB(2)723/02-03]

The minutes of the meetings held on 22 November 2002 and 4 December 2002 were confirmed.

#### II. Clause-by-clause examination of the Bill

[LC Paper Nos. CB(3)16/02-03, CB(2)115/02-03(02), CB(2)553/02-03(01) and CB(2)679/02-03(01)]

2. The Committee deliberated and completed clause-by-clause examination of clauses 1 to 9 of the Bill (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

#### Part 1 of the Bill (Preliminary)

#### Clause 3

3. Members noted that the Administration had already prepared the maps of the Existing Villages listed in Schedule 1 and had arranged to post up the maps in the District Offices in the New Territories, offices of the Rural Committees (RCs), village offices and the notice boards in the villages concerned in July and August 2002 to invite comments from residents concerned. Mr Albert CHAN expressed dissatisfaction with the arrangement. He pointed out that since residents living in remote "peripheral areas" who would most likely be affected might not be able to see the maps or aware of their availability, they might not have the opportunity to comment on the boundaries of the Villages. Mr CHAN reiterated that it was unfair if these residents who had all along been living in the village and had participated in previous Village Representative (VR) elections could not participate in the next round of VR elections. He considered that the Administration should inform the residents concerned in writing of the availability of the maps so as to allow them the opportunity to comment on the maps. Mr CHAN requested that his views be recorded.

#### Part 2 of the Bill (Office of VR)

#### Clause 6

4. Mr Albert CHAN considered that to avoid conflicts arising from the overlap in the functions of the two types of VRs, the function of the Indigenous Inhabitant Representative for an Indigenous Village or a Composite Indigenous Village stipulated in clause 6(4)(a) of the Bill should be amended to the effect that he would be responsible for reflecting views on behalf of the indigenous inhabitants of the Village on affairs related to their lawful traditional rights and interests and their traditional way of life. He said that he would propose a Committee Stage amendment (CSA) to the Bill to such an effect if the Administration refused to accept his suggestion.

#### Clause 9

- 5. <u>Members</u> noted the response from the Administration dated 12 December 2002 [LC Paper No. CB(2)679/02-03(04)] to the suggestions raised by members at the meeting on 4 December 2002 that it remained of the view that civil servants should not be allowed to run for or hold office as VR.
- 6. <u>Members</u> agreed that the Bills Committee would move a CSA to delete clause 9(1)(a)(ii) and other relevant proposed provisions from the Bill so that a

prescribed public officer would be allowed to run for or to hold office as VR. Members noted that a public officer would be disqualified from holding office as an ex officio member of the District Council concerned under section 19(1)(a)(ii) of the District Council Ordinance (Cap. 547). They agreed that a VR who was a prescribed public officer should be allowed to become a RC chairman, if elected. Assistant Legal Adviser was requested to prepare the CSA for members' consideration at the next meeting.
