I. Confirmation of minutes

[LC Paper Nos. CB(2)380/03-04 and CB(2)533/03-04]

The minutes of the meetings held on 7 and 13 November 2003 were confirmed.

II. Meeting with the Administration [LC Paper No. CB(2)532/03-04(01) circulated to members]

2. <u>Members</u> deliberated on the Administration's response to issues raised at the meetings on 7 and 13 November 2003 [LC Paper No. CB(2)532/03-04(01)] (Index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

Protection of Incorporated Management Committee (IMC) managers against legal liabilities

3. <u>Members</u> deliberated on the scope of the Block Insurance Policy (BIP) for aided schools. Members in general expressed concern that under BIP, IMC managers were not protected from legal liabilities such as professional liability, employment practices liability and educators legal liability. In response to members' request, Hon Bernard CHAN briefed members on the scope and estimated costs of professional indemnity and Directors and Officers liability insurance, which could provide protection to IMC managers against the liabilities excluded under BIP.

4. The Administration explained that an IMC was an independent legal entity which would be held responsible for civil liabilities arising from its acts in its own name. Under the Bill, proposed new section 40BG provided that IMC managers would not incur personal civil liabilities when discharging their duties as managers if they had acted in good faith. To further protect IMC managers, the Administration would move a Committee Stage amendment to specify in the Bill that any claim for liability shall be enforced against the IMC to the exclusion of managers.

5. Members requested the Administration to examine whether professional Adm indemnity and Directors and Officers liability insurance should be included under BIP to further protect IMC managers against legal liabilities. Members also considered that the Administration should consult School Sponsoring Bodies on the matter, and briefed serving and prospective IMC managers on the legal liabilities which were not covered under the current BIP.

III. Any other business

Meeting with deputations

6. Members agreed to hold two meetings on 14 and 16 January 2004 at 8:30 am to receive deputations. Mr CHEUNG Man-kwong requested the Adm/Clerk Administration to collaborate with the Secretariat to prepare an updated summary of response to members' concerns in a user friendly style for distribution to the deputations and individuals to be invited to attend the meeting on 14 or 16 January 2004.
