I. Meeting with the Administration

The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

- 2. The Bills Committee requested the Administration to provide a paper explaining the legal effect of terms such as "Her Majesty", "Her Majesty's forces", "Governor", "British National", "United Kingdom", "England", "Her Majesty's service" and "Government of the United Kingdom" in the Crimes Ordinance, Official Secrets Ordinance, Post Office Ordinance and Criminal Procedure Ordinance, if they were not adapted.
- 3. The Bills Committee requested the Legislative Council Secretariat to obtain information on -
 - (a) whether it was the usual practice of Bills Committees to hold meetings with the Administration to discuss the bill in between meetings to receive the views of the public; and
 - (b) views of Bills Committees on adaptation of laws regarding whether the scope of adaptation of laws was very narrow and any amendment exceeding such a scope should be implemented by way of an amendment bill

- 4. <u>Mr James TO</u> suggested that discussions on the Bill should be deferred until the information referred to in paragraph 3 above was available. As there were divided views among members, a vote was taken on the suggestion. 13 members voted in favour of the suggestion while 17 members voted against.
- 5. <u>Mr James TO</u> also suggested that a three-month period should be allowed for consultation with the public and the Bills Committee would not hold meetings to discuss the Bill with the Administration during the period. As there were divided views among members, a vote was taken on the suggestion. 13 members voted in favour of the suggestion while 18 members voted against.

II. Dates of subsequent meetings

- 6. The Bills Committee agreed that -
 - (a) future meetings with the Administration would be held on every Tuesday from 2:30 pm to 6:30 pm; and
 - (b) meetings to receive the views of the public on the Bill would be held on Saturday, 12 and 26 April 2003 from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm.
- 7. The Bills Committee noted that the next meeting had been scheduled for Thursday, 27 March 2003 at 8:30 am to continue discussion with the Administration.
- 8. The meeting ended at 10:55 am.
