I. Meeting with the Administration

The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

- 2. The Bills Committee requested the Administration to provide a written response to the following issues raised and information sought by members in relation to proscription of local organizations -
 - (a) to provide information on the relevant overseas legislation and cases relating to special procedures;
 - (b) to provide information on the functions of a special advocate in the United Kingdom;
 - (c) in relation to the "legal practitioner" referred to in new section 8E(4)(a) and (b) of the Societies Ordinance (SO), to explain -

- (i) what such a legal practitioner could and could not do;
- (ii) how such a legal practitioner would be selected, and whether an appellant could appoint a legal practitioner of his choice;
- (d) to consider deleting "國家安全利益" in new section 8A(1) and substituting "國家安全"; and
- (e) to provide information on claims for damages from appellants who succeeded in their appeals against proscription.
- 3. Secretary for Security informed members that the Administration would propose amendments to section 8 of SO so that the proscription of a local organization on the ground of national security would be dealt with under new section 8A but not section 8 of SO.
- 4. The meeting ended at 12:30 pm.
