

**Legislative Council Bills Committee on
Legislative Council (Amendment) Bill 2003**

Delineation of Functional Constituency Electorate

We have made various proposals to adjust the delineation of the electorate of certain functional constituencies (FCs) to ensure that the composition of the FCs reflects the latest developments in the relevant sectors. The detailed proposals are set out in the LegCo Brief issued to Members in February 2003 (Ref. CAB C1/30/5), and two papers issued to the Bills Committee (LC Paper No. CB(2)2256/02-03(01) and LC Paper No. CB(2)2324/02-03(01)).

2. As requested by Members at the meeting on 5 June 2003, we now provide at the **Annex** for the Committee's reference a comparison of the existing potential electorate of all FCs with their potential electorate after adjustments, if any. A breakdown of the electorate into corporate and individual electors is also provided as requested.

3. Members may wish to note that the number of potential electors of individual FCs fluctuates from time to time due to changes in the membership sizes of umbrella organizations. The figures provided in the Annex are based on the most up to date information available to the Registration and Electoral Office.
