I. Election of Chairman

Ms Cyd HO was elected Chairman of the Bills Committee.

II. Meeting with the Administration

[Legislative Council Brief: EMB(SCR) 22/58/03 Pt.5]

2. The Bills Committee deliberated (Index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

Raising the professional standards of teachers

- 3. <u>Members</u> expressed support for the policy direction of raising the professional standards of teachers. They, however, were of the view that serving permitted teachers (PTs) had reasonable expectations that they could become registered teachers (RTs) under the existing arrangements by accumulating years of service without going through proper teacher training. If the existing arrangements would be abolished, a transitional period should be allowed. <u>Members</u> requested the Administration -
 - (a) to provide the justification (inclusive of the recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Teacher Education and Qualifications) for abolishing the existing arrangements;
 - (b) to provide for a transitional period for serving PTs to register as RTs subject to such requirements for taking approved education programmes as the Permanent Secretary for Education and Manpower might specify;
 - (c) to specify a deadline for serving PTs to register their intention to pursue an approved teacher education programme if a transitional period was provided for; and

(d) to grant priority to these PTs in the allocation of places of approved teacher education programmes.

4. <u>Members</u> also requested the Administration -

- (a) to consider applying the proposed qualification requirements of post-secondary level to PTs teaching grammatical secondary school courses in educational institutions other than full day schools e.g. matriculation classes in tutorial schools; and
- (b) to consult the views of tutorial school operators on the impact of the proposal in paragraph 4(a) above.

Registration of day and evening schools

5. <u>Members</u> requested the Administration -

- (a) to explain the application of the proposal of requiring only one registration for a day and evening school to different modes of school operation e.g. a Direct Subsidy Scheme school running a self-financing evening school and a evening school running in an aided school by a different school sponsoring body; and
- (b) to elaborate on the accounting arrangements and requirements for a evening school if section 10(2) of the existing Education Ordinance (the Ordinance) was repealed.

Appeal Boards Panel

6. <u>Members</u> requested the Administration -

- (a) to explain the justifications for proposing a new Appeal Boards Panel to replace the Appeals Board under existing section 59 of the Ordinance, and elaborate on the role and functions of the proposed Appeal Boards Panel, its composition and operation as well as the criteria for the appointment of its members;
- (b) to explain the reasons for not specifying in the proposed amended section 59 that at least three of the members of the proposed Appeal Boards Panel shall be RTs and that an Appeal Board shall not hear or determine any appeal concerning the registration of a teacher or the cancellation of the registration of a teacher unless the members comprising the Appeal Board included RTs, as similar provisions had been included in the existing section 59 of the Ordinance; and

- (c) to further elaborate on the rationale for allowing the Secretary for Justice to appoint any legally qualified person to assist an Appeal Board.
- 7. The Administration also agreed to provide a written response to the questions raised by Mr CHEUNG Man-Kwong as listed in his letter [LC Paper No.CB(2) 2831/02-03(02)].

III. Any other business

- 8. <u>Members</u> agreed that after perusal of the Administration's response to the issues raised at the meeting, the Bills Committee would discuss at the next meeting to be held in September 2003 the way forward in respect of meeting deputations.
- 9. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 12:25 pm.
