I Meeting with the Administration

[LC Paper No. CB(2) 3028/02-03(01) and CB(2) 2716/02-03(02)]

The Bills Committee deliberated (Index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

- 2. The Administration and the Secretary General of Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) briefed the Bills Committee on the policy objectives of the Bill and the existing and proposed arrangements for ensuring secrecy of the examination papers. The Secretary General of HKEAA also informed members of the requests received for holding examinations in places outside Hong Kong.
- 3. At the request of the Chairman, the Administration agreed to provide copies of the text of the relevant legislation in the Mainland on the offences and penalties in relation to breach of secrecy and leakage of examination papers.
- 4. As regards the Chairman's request for the provision of samples or extract of the relevant provisions of the contractual agreements entered between HKEAA and overseas or professional examination bodies, the Administration explained that it would have to seek the consent of the relevant organisations for disclosing the provisions to a third party.
- 5. As requested by Ms Audrey EU, the legal adviser to the Bills Committee and the Government Counsel would review the drafting of the proposed section 7(1) to ensure consistency between the Chinese and English versions.
- 6. The Chairman expressed concern about the actual arrangements to be made by HKEAA and its partner organisations to conduct examinations outside Hong Kong, especially the arrangements to ensure confidentiality of the examination papers. She requested the Administration to provide further details to the Panel on Education when ready. Principal Assistant Secretary for Education and Manpower (Quality Assurance) (PAS(EM)(QA)) agreed.

Clause-by-clause examination of the Bill

7. The Bills Committee completed clause-by-clause examination of the Bill.

Legislative time-table

8. The Chairman said that since the Bills Committee had completed scrutiny of the Bill, further information on the Bill to be provided by the Administration would be circulated to members for consideration. The Chairman advised that unless members or the legal adviser would like to raise further issues for discussion, the Bills Committee would not hold further meetings. She suggested that a report be made to the House Committee in October 2003. Members agreed. In response to the Chairman, PAS(EM)(QA) said that the Administration would advise the date for resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill later.

9. The meeting ended at 12:10 pm.
