I. Meeting with the Administration

(LC Paper Nos. CB(2)2634/03-04(01) and CB(2)2659/03-04(01))

The Bills Committee deliberated (Index of proceedings at **Annex**).

2. The Administration was requested to include the implementation of the United Nations International Convention for the Suppression of Terrorist Bombings, the United Nations Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts Against the Safety of Maritime Navigation and the United Nations Protocol for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts Against the Safety of Fixed Platforms Located on the Continental Shelf in the long title of the United Nations (Anti-Terrorism Measures) Ordinance (Cap. 575).
3. The Administration was also invited to give its comments on Mr Albert HO's proposed Committee Stage amendments (CSAs) to clause 14 of the Bill.
4. The Administration was further requested to provide information on the Joint Financial Intelligence Unit's procedures for handling suspicious transaction reports filed under section 25A of the Drug Trafficking (Recovery of Proceeds) Ordinance (Cap. 405) and the Organized and Serious Crimes Ordinance (Cap. 455), and section 12 of Cap. 575. The Administration should also advise how these procedures would allow for the proper implementation of new section 12(6)(b) of Cap. 575 and new section 25A(9)(b) of Cap. 405 and Cap. 455.
5. Subject to the Administration's response mentioned in paragraph 4 above, members agreed that the Chairman should make a verbal report to the House Committee on 11 June 2004 recommending the resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill at the Council meeting on 30 June 2004. A written report would be submitted to the House Committee on 18 June 2004. Members noted that the deadline for giving notice to move CSAs was 19 June 2004.

6. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 9:55 am.
