<u>Clause</u>	<u>Amendment Proposed</u>
Long Title	By adding “, and to restrict the circumstances in which disclosure is required under section 12(1) of that Ordinance” after “may be disclosed”.
New	By adding –  <b>“7A Disclosure of knowledge or suspicion that property is terrorist property, etc.</b> Section 12(1) is repealed and the following substituted – “(1) Where a person knows or suspects on the basis of information or other matter which comes to his attention in the course of a trade, profession, business or employment that any property is terrorist property, then the person shall disclose to an authorized officer the information or other matter on which the knowledge or suspicion is based as soon as is practicable after that information or other matter comes to a person’s attention.”.
