- 2. The Bills Committee requested the Administration -
 - (a) to revise the drafting of the proposed section 32(c) of the Adoption Ordinance (AO) to provide the Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food with the power to make regulations on the suspension or revocation of accreditation; and
 - (b) to revise the drafting of the proposed Schedule 4 to AO, having regard to the views expressed by members.
- 3. The Chairman concluded that, subject to the revised Committee Stage amendments to be provided by the Administration, the Bills Committee supported the resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill at the Council meeting on 7 July 2004.
