Bills

First Reading

Education Reorganization (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2002

The Bill was read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

Second Reading

Education Reorganization (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2002

The Secretary for Education and Manpower moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Members' Motions

Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance

1. Karaoke Establishments (Licensing) Regulation and Karaoke Establishments (Fees) Regulation

Hon Audrey EU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that in relation to the -

- (a) Karaoke Establishments (Licensing) Regulation, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 153 of 2002; and
- (b) Karaoke Establishments (Fees) Regulation, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 154 of 2002,

and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 30 October 2002, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 18 December 2002.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

As Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, who was to move the next motion, was not in the Chamber, the President suspended the meeting at 4:22 pm.

The Council resumed at 4:26 pm.

2. Patents (General) (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules 2002

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that in relation to the Patents (General) (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules 2002, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 157 of 2002 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 30 October 2002, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 18 December 2002.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

3. Chinese Medicine (Fees) Regulation, Chinese Medicines Regulation and Chinese Medicines Traders (Regulatory) Regulation

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that in relation to the -

- (a) Chinese Medicine (Fees) Regulation, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 159 of 2002;
- (b) Chinese Medicines Regulation, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 160 of 2002; and
- (c) Chinese Medicines Traders (Regulatory) Regulation, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 161 of 2002,

and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 6 November 2002, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 8 January 2003.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Developing elevated pedestrian walkway systems

Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to adopt the "pedestrian priority" principle and conduct a territory-wide review of elevated pedestrian walkway systems, with a view to developing, at suitable locations, elevated pedestrian walkway systems that have sight-seeing value, are well-connected and have special features, and to improving the environment for pedestrians as well as facilities to complement shopping arcades and transport services; to co-ordinate the development of elevated pedestrian walkway systems, the Government should also formulate policies, design codes and specific measures to achieve the goals of improving street-side air quality, minimizing vehicle-pedestrian scrambles and providing barrier-free facilities, thereby enhancing pedestrian safety and the quality of the environment for walking.

Question on Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon IP Kwok-him would move an amendment to the motion and that Dr Hon YEUNG Sum would also move an amendment to Hon IP Kwok-him's amendment. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion, the amendment, and the amendment to the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon IP Kwok-him moved the following amendment to Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "elevated" after "That this Council urges the Government to adopt the 'pedestrian priority' principle and conduct a territory-wide review of"; and to add "and without affecting the business environment of the operators concerned" after "with a view to developing, at suitable locations".

Question on Hon IP Kwok-him's amendment to Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion proposed.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum moved the following amendment to Hon IP Kwok-him's amendment and addressed the Council:

To add ", as far as possible," after "with a view to developing, at suitable locations and".

Question on Dr Hon YEUNG Sum's amendment to Hon IP Kwok-him's amendment proposed.

Four Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Question on Dr Hon YEUNG Sum's amendment to Hon IP Kwok-him's amendment put.

Hon IP Kwok-him claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 20 were present, seven were in favour of the amendment, 12 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 22 were present, 15 were in favour of the amendment and six against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that Dr Hon YEUNG Sum's amendment to Hon IP Kwok-him's amendment was negatived.

Question on Hon IP Kwok-him's amendment to Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion put.

Hon Fred LI claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 23 were present, 19 were in favour of the amendment and four abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 23 were present, 10 were in favour of the amendment, two against it and 10 abstained. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that Hon IP Kwok-him's amendment to Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion was negatived.

Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong replied.

Question on Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion put.

Hon CHAN Kam-lam claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 23 were present, five were in favour of the motion, 17 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 24 were present, 17 were in favour of the motion and six against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was

not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Next Meeting

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 27 November 2002 at 2:30 pm.

The Council was adjourned at 5:49 pm.


