<b>236CL</b> PWSC(2002-03)74 (Head 705)	Tai O development, package 4, stage II engineering works	To recommend to Finance Committee the upgrading of <b>236CL</b> , retitled "Tai O Development - Sheltered Boat Anchorage", to Category A at an estimated cost of \$287.5 million in money-of-the-day prices for the construction of a sheltered boat anchorage area and provision of a mangrove replanting area at Tai O.
<b>96ET</b> PWSC(2002-03)75 (Head 703)	Special school in Area 3, Yuen Long, for moderately mentally handicapped children	To recommend to Finance Committee the upgrading of <b>96ET</b> to Category A at an estimated cost of \$78 million in money-of-the-day prices for the construction of a special school with boarding section in Area 3, Yuen Long, for moderately mentally handicapped children.
<b>373RO</b> PWSC(2002-03)76 (Head 703)	District open space in Area 7, Tung Chung	To recommend to Finance Committee the upgrading of <b>373RO</b> to Category A at an estimated cost of \$58.7 million in money-of-the-day prices for the development of a district open space in Area 7, Tung Chung.
<b>384RO</b> PWSC(2002-03)77 (Head 703)	Improvement to Lok Wah Playground, Kwun Tong	To recommend to Finance Committee the upgrading of <b>384RO</b> to Category A at an estimated cost of \$44.9 million in money-of-the-day prices for the improvement of Lok Wah Playground, Kwun Tong.
