Supplementary Information on 242LP – Marine Police Outer Waters District Headquarters and Marine Police North Division at Ma Liu Shui, Sha Tin

INTRODUCTION

In considering PWSC(2003-04)25 on **242LP** at the Public Works Subcommittee meeting on 25 June 2003, Members requested the Administration to provide further information on –

- (a) the number of cases handled at the Report Room of Marine Police North Division (MNDIV) in the past few years; and
- (b) the annual recurrent costs incurred by Marine Police Outer Waters District Headquarters (MOWDIST HQ) and MNDIV before and after the proposed reprovisioning.

THE ADMINISTRATION'S RESPONSE

Number of Cases handled at Report Room

2. The Report Room and related facilities of MNDIV, like any other report room in a police station, is the centre of the Division where members of the public are received, reports are recorded and processed, enquiries are dealt with, and arrested persons are interviewed, searched and detained on a temporary basis. It is also the place where documentations relating to summons enforcement action are processed and properties that come into the custody of police are safely handled.

- 3. Due to the shortage of accommodation in the existing base, only an area of about 6m² can be allocated for use as a "Report Room" without the provision of any related facilities. The area is just sufficient for answering public enquiries. MNDIV officers are required to carry out other work involving members of the public in the Fitness Room. Such an arrangement is not conducive to operational efficiency.
- 4. To provide for a suitable environment to conduct the above mentioned Police duties, at least 103m^2 will be required for the Report Room and related facilities. These will include working area for staff and public area (44m^2), a documentation room (10m^2), two search cubicles (13m^2), temporary holding area for arrested persons (30m^2) and a temporary property depository (6m^2). The proposed Report Room and related facilities of MNDIV will still be smaller than those in other standard Police Stations. For instance, the sizes of the Report Room and related facilities in Waterfront Divisional Police Station and North Point Police Station are 265m^2 and 320m^2 respectively.
- 5. Statistics relating to cases handled at the Report Room of MNDIV in the past three years are as follow -

Additional Recurrent Expenditures

6. The annual recurrent expenditure of the new building is estimated at \$4,144,792. This represents an increase by \$1,910,922 from the existing charges of \$2,233,870. The increase is mainly due to the extension of accommodation and provision of adequate facilities in the new building to alleviate the acute shortage of space in the existing MNDIV Operational Base. After the proposed reprovisioning, the annual cost for building maintenance will be decreased by \$458,650.

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In this context, "reports" mean all incidents, cases and matters handled at the Report Room and related facilities. These include enquiries initiated by the public or the Police and all relevant Police actions such as arrests, vessel/house searches, raids, etc.

7. A comparison of the breakdown of the annual recurrent expenditures incurred by the existing MOWDIST HQ and MNDIV and the proposed new Headquarters and Operational Base is as follows –
