“鑒於香港特別行政區政府與中央政府已簽署‘內地與香港更緊密經貿關係安排’，為本港製造業和服務業等提供了拓展市場的機遇，本會促請政府從速制訂相關措施，包括簡化各類牌照申領手續、加強保障知識產權等，以改善營商環境，吸引更多企業來港投資；本會並促請政府擴大在內地對港資企業的支援網絡，協助港商加強在內地城市推廣宣傳，使港資企業能充分利用有關安排所提供的商機，製造更多就業機會，改善經濟。”

**Motion on “Mainland/Hong Kong Closer
Economic Partnership Arrangement”
to be moved by Hon CHAN Kam-lam
at the Legislative Council meeting
of Wednesday, 9 July 2003**

Wording of the Motion

“That, as the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government and the Central Government have signed the ‘Mainland/Hong Kong Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement’, which provides market development opportunities for Hong Kong’s manufacturing and service industries, this Council urges the Government to expeditiously formulate relevant measures, such as streamlining various licensing procedures and enhancing intellectual property protection, in order to improve the business environment and attract more enterprises to invest in Hong Kong; this Council also urges the Government to expand its support network in the Mainland for Hong Kong enterprises and assist Hong Kong businessmen in strengthening their promotion and publicity efforts in Mainland cities, so as to enable Hong Kong enterprises to make full use of the business opportunities brought about by the above Arrangement, thereby creating more employment opportunities and improving the economy.”
