 - (b) deleting the word "normal" in section 5(7)(m) and section 16(5)(h); and

- (c) deleting the phrase "for a full day" from section 19(2)(b).
- 5. Members raised no other queries on the draft Bylaw.

6. <u>Members</u> agreed that the Administration and the Ocean Park Corporation should incorporate the amendments set out in paragraph 4 above and provide the draft Ocean Park Bylaw as amended for circulation to members. If members raised no queries on the draft Bylaw as amended, the Subcommittee would report to the House Committee that it did not object to the gazettal of the draft Bylaw.
