<u>Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration of Electors) (Village Representative Election) Regulation</u>

Adm 3. The Administration had undertaken to –

- (a) make administrative arrangements to follow up with the Indigenous Villages and Composite Indigenous Villages voter applicants for their principal residential address/postal address to be included in the register for reference if the principal residential address had not been provided on the application forms; and
- (b) amend section 32(7) and (8) to exclude reference to section 24 of the Village Representative Election Ordinance (Cap. 576) from the provisions in the next miscellaneous legislative amendment exercise to be conducted by the Department of Justice.
- 4. <u>Members</u> suggested that the Secretary for Home Affairs should consider making a statement on the follow-up action in respect of paragraph 3(a) above. The Administration agreed to consider the suggestion and provide a written response.
