I. Election of Chairman

Mr Michael MAK was elected Chairman of the Subcommttee.

II. Meeting with the Administration

- 2. The Subcommittee deliberated (Index of proceedings at Annex).
- 3. <u>Members</u> expressed support of the Quarantine and Prevention of Disease Ordinance (Amendment of First Schedule) Order 2003 and the Prevention of the Spread of Infectious Diseases Regulations (Amendment of Form) Order 2003 (the Amendment Orders) which they agreed were necessary.
- 4. The Administration was requested to provide a written response on the following questions raised by members at the meeting in two weeks' time -
 - (a) Measures being taken so far under the Amendment Orders, and the relevant authority as provided in the Quarantine and Prevention of Disease Ordinance (Cap.141) and its subsidiary legislation; and

- (b) Information relating to granting of paid sick leave for pregnant employees during a German measles outbreak in Hong Kong some years ago.
- 5. As Cap. 141 was enacted in 1936, the Administration was also requested to review the Ordinance and provide in two weeks' time a written response on whether further amendments were necessary.
- 6. In order to enhance co-operation of the community, <u>Miss Margaret NG</u> suggested that clear guidelines similar to those relating to the Industrial Safety Regulations should be provided to the public. <u>The Administration</u> pointed out that quite a number of pamphlets providing guidelines for prevention of the disease had been produced for distribution to the public and such information was constantly being updated. <u>The Administration</u> nevertheless agreed to consider Miss NG's suggestion.

III. Any other business

- 7. <u>Members</u> agreed that the issues raised at the meeting should be followed up by the Panel on Health Services and that it was not necessary for the Subcommittee to hold further meetings. <u>Members</u> further agreed that a report summarising the deliberations of the Subcommittee be submitted for the House Committee meeting on 11 April 2003.
- 8. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 4:32 pm.
