I Confirmation of minutes of meeting

[LC Paper No. CB(2) 2272/02-03]

The minutes of the meeting on 26 May 2003 were confirmed.

II Meeting with the Administration

[LC Paper Nos. CB(2) 2176/02-03(02), CB(2) 2269/02-03(01) and 2290/02-03(01) - (04)]

2. <u>The Administration</u> briefed members on its response to issues raised at the last meeting and took members through the paper comparing the relevant sections in the Fire Services (Fire Hazard Abatement) Regulation (the Regulation) with sections 9 and 9A to 9D repealed by the Fire Services (Amendment) Ordinance 2003.

3. The Subcommittee deliberated and completed clause-by-clause examination of the Regulation and its schedules (Index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

4. <u>Members</u> had no strong views to the Administration's proposal of retaining the words "犯" in sub-paragraph 22(1) and "識別" in sub-paragraph 28(a) of the Regulation.

5. <u>The legal adviser</u> advised that sections 2 to 16 of the Regulation, to the extent that they sought to re-enact sections 9 and 9A to 9D of the Fire Services Ordinance (FSO), reflected the policy intent of and had the same legal effect as the abovementioned provisions of FSO. She drew members' attention to the increase in the level of fines under sections 9, 12(1), 13(4), 14(2), 15(2) and 16(4) of the Regulation. <u>The Chairman</u> advised that the proposed increase in fines had been discussed and agreed to by the Bills Committee on Fire Services (Amendment) Bill 2001.

6. <u>Principal Assistant Secretary for Security</u> informed members that the Administration was discussing with the legal adviser some technical issues related to the Regulation, and would provide a written response in due course.

7. <u>The Chairman</u> said that to allow time for the Administration to provide response to the outstanding issues, and for the Subcommittee to report to the House Committee, he would move a motion at the Council meeting on 11 June 2003 to extend the scrutiny period to 2 July 2003. If members had no further queries to the Administration's response to be provided, the Subcommittee would report to the House Committee on 20 June 2003. <u>Members agreed</u>.

III Any other business

8. <u>Mr LAU Ping-cheung</u> commented that it was desirable that a subcommittee appointed to scrutinise an item of subsidiary legislation should comprise members who had participated in the scrutiny of the relevant principal legislation. He requested that the matter be raised at a House Committee meeting. <u>The Chairman</u> said that Members were free to join any committee they wished to, but he would raise Mr LAU's suggestion when he reported on the deliberations of the Subcommittee.

9. The meeting ended at 11:55 am.
