Action

**I. Election of Chairman**

Ms Cyd HO was elected Chairman of the Subcommittee.

## **II. The way forward**

2. The Chairman invited members' views on whether a meeting should be scheduled for the Subcommittee to receive views from the relevant parties such as contractors, subcontractors and sub-subcontractors of the construction industry on the proposed amendments to the four Regulations under the Factories and Undertakings Ordinance. Mr LEE Cheuk-yan said that given the Labour Advisory Board had been consulted and endorsed the proposed amendments, public consultation might not be necessary. Mr LEUNG Fu-wah shared Mr LEE's view and added that there were practical difficulties to locate these contractors, subcontractors and sub-subcontractors as there were too many in the industry. The Chairman urged members to relay to the relevant parties that the Subcommittee was prepared to receive views on the proposed amendments. Subject to the response received, the Subcommittee would consider whether there was a need to consult the public at the next meeting.

3. Members agreed that the next meeting would be held on Wednesday, 16 July 2003 at 2:30 pm to meet with the Administration.
