#### I Election of Chairman

Mr CHAN Kwok-keung was elected Chairman of the Subcommittee.

### II. Meeting with the Administration

[LC Paper No. CB(2) 2542/02-03(03)]

- 2. The Subcommittee deliberated (Index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).
- 3. <u>Members</u> were generally in support of the proposal of adding the audio-visual and radio-frequency mechanic, and building services mechanic trades to the list of designated trades under the Apprenticeship Ordinance.
- 4. Noting that there were presently about 75 apprentices in the trades of audiovisual and radio-frequency mechanic, and building services mechanic, Ms LI Fungying asked whether some of them were employed under the Youth Work Experience and Training Scheme (the Scheme). As participating employers under the Scheme were entitled to a monthly training subsidy of \$2,000 for each trainee during the employment and training period, Ms LI asked whether employers would cease to receive such subsidies as they would have to enter into a contract of apprenticeship with employees originally employed under the Scheme. If so, she was concerned that some employers might cease to employ these young people with the coming into effect of the Order. The other members of the Subcommittee agreed with Ms LI.
- 5. The Subcommittee suggested that the Administration should give an undertaking that the Scheme could run in parallel with the requirement of entering into a contract of apprenticeship with employees under the Scheme. Some members suggested that an alternative was for the Administration to consider extending the grace period for those young people employed under the Scheme to enter into a contract of apprenticeship only after they had completed the employment and training period of the Scheme.

6. <u>The Administration</u> responded that it would provide a response to members' concern after discussing with the Economic Development and Labour Bureau.

## III. Any other business

- 7. The Chairman requested the Administration to provide a response by 24 June 2003 for circulation to members of the Subcommittee. Subject to members' agreement to the Administration's response, no further meeting would be held, and a report would be provided to the House Committee. The Chairman further said that if members were not satisfied with the Administration's response, further meetings would be held and he would move a motion at the Council meeting on 2 July 2003 to extend the scrutiny period of the Order and the Notice to the first Council meeting in the next session. Members agreed.
