## Subcommittee on Apprenticeship (Designation of Trades) Order 2003 and Apprenticeship (Periods of Apprenticeship) Notice 2003

At the Subcommittee meeting held on 20 June, Members expressed concern that the specification of Audio-Visual and Radio-Frequency Mechanics and Building Services Mechanics as designated trades might result in early termination of contracts of young people who are currently employed under the Youth Work Experience and Training Scheme (YWETS) as employers may no longer be eligible for the monthly training subsidy of \$2,000 under YWETS. In view of this, Members requested the Administration to consider granting exemption of registration under the Apprenticeship Ordinance (the Ordinance) to those youth workers in these two designated trades during the term of their existing YWETS contracts.

We have checked with the Labour Department (LD) and confirmed with the Office of the Director of Apprenticeship that no young person aged between 14 and 18 is currently employed in the two trades under YWETS. As such, the designation of the two trades will not affect existing contracts under YWETS.

With this clarification, I hope that Members will consider the merits of the designation and support the captioned legislation.
